Helene Feldbauer – mezzosoprano



The Austrian mezzosoprano Helene Feldbauer studied at the University of Music and Performing Arts Vienna with Margit Klaushofer, lied with Florian Boesch, opera with Christoph Ulrich Meier and graduated with honors.

She was a member of the Frankfurt Opera Studio from the 2022/23 to 2023/24, where she made her debut as one of the apprentices in the premiere series of Wagner's *Die Meistersinger von Nürnberg*. With roles like the Second Maid in *Elektra*, the Boy in Kurt Weill's opera *Der Zar läst sich fotografieren*, Cherubino in *Le nozze di Figaro*, as Zweite Magd in both *Daphne* and *Elektra*, she could expand her repertoire on this prestigious stage and will return as a guest.

Before becoming a singer, she completed her studies in music and instrumental music education at the University of Mozarteum in Salzburg, where she, as a clarinetist and oboist for many years, discovered her fascination for singing. In Vienna she has already taken part in opera productions at the university: as the Composer (*Ariadne auf Naxos*), Fidalma (*II matrimonio segreto*), Libellule, Bergère, Tasse

Chinoise (*L'enfant et les sortilèges*), Madame Larina (*Eugene Onegin*), Hänsel (*Hänsel und Gretel*), Cornelia (*Giulio Cesare*), Marcellina (*Le nozze di Figaro*), which she already performed in autumn 2017 as part of the Angelika Prokopp Summer Academy of the Vienna Philharmonics at the Vienna Concert House, Music society Graz and Palace Thalheim.

In spring 2020, Helene Feldbauer won the International Singing Competition of the Chamber Opera Schloss Rheinsberg. In September 2021 she was a finalist in the cross-over competition in Baden nearby Vienna and is the prizewinner of the mdw great talent award 2022. In 2023 Helene was awarded the prestigious **Richard Wagner Scholarship**.

In the summer of 2023, Helene sang the innkeeper's daughter in *Königskinder* at the Summer Festival in Erl, where she had previously performed as Orlowsky in December of the preceding year. This summer she returned to Erl and performed the role of Ljubov in Matthew Wild's acclaimed production of Mazeppa and Siegrune in Fassbaender's Ring in "Die Walküre".

Since March 2022 she has been giving regularly concerts with the Duo Minerva. They perform specially arranged Viennese songs.
